Requires the minimum wage for specified employers to be increased by not less than specified amounts each year for a specified time period. Requires an annual report on whether economic conditions can support a scheduled minimum wage increase, and the use of sales and use tax therefor. Requires reporting of any General Fund revenue lost or gained by the state or local government.
